

Public Safety Meeting Minutes March 2, 2026

Those present were Supervisor Will Rivera, Brett Holleran, Trish Riddell Kent and Josh Youngquist (SUNY Media)

Ways of slowing down traffic at Richard's and Blanchard Ave intersection were discussed. One of our colleagues was hit by a vehicle driving too fast. Using one of the Town's Speed Signs was the first logical step that can be implemented. Trish will refer this to tomorrow's Highway Committee Meeting. (It was noted that our standard practice using 811 Dig Safe with gas lines in the area when placing the sign.) Calming speed bumps/speed humps are another possibility. Also contacting the Sheriff's office with Speed Trailer request was another suggestion. PRK noted that a resident, who is a father of children, reached out about concerns of traffic speeding in this location which is also a school bus stop. We must do whatever we can to protect the public.

We reviewed Code Enforcement update. 11 Raymond has hired a service to remove junk. Court appearance was recommended for 133 Southside Dr.

We will request Code Officer to continue to address Swart Hollow Rd property.

Hazard Mitigation Plan was discussed and Trish reminded the committee that we have to quickly work towards the final completion deadline by the end of this month. Will reminded the committee that our FEMA funding requires this HMP being updated.

The Supervisor sent out an Emergency Services email to the Town Board.
