No work is to be performed from OCTOBER 15 to APRIL 15, except in emergency situations and with the approval of the Town of Oneonta designated Water Operator.

Indemnification Agreement

For the purposes of this agreement, the term "Indemnitor" shall mean any individual, corporation, or party engaging in any contract with the Town of Oneonta for the purpose of providing work, labor, and services or materials as a result of any separate agreement or arrangement with the Town of Oneonta for the same. The term "Indemnitor" shall also include any part, whether for compensation or otherwise, conducting or sponsoring any events which utilize Town Property, or involve permission for use of Town Roads or Equipment in furtherance of any activities sponsored or undertaken by any such Individual, Corporation, or Party.

The above named Indemnitor, and Indemnitee, Town of Oneonta, hereby agree as follows:

1. In consideration for the Town Consenting to Indemnitor's activities, or in consideration for the work, labor, and services to be performed and materials to be provided from Indemnitor to Indemnitee, as set forth in separate documents between the parties, and expense including Attorney's fees and defense costs, which the Indemnitee may incur by reason of any claim or cause of actions what so ever brought against the Indemnitee as a result of any actions taken by Indemnitor or furtherance of performance of it's activities under the agreement between the parties. The term "loss or damage" includes any and all expenses incurred in defending any claims, causes of action or litigation brought on by any third parties against Indemnitee arising out of the relationship between the parties. Such term shall include, but is not limited to, any sums which in the sole discretion of the Indemnitee are reasonably required to be paid in settlement of any such claim, whether as a result of a Court or Jury verdict, or as a result of any out-of-pocket or pretrial settlement reached by Indemnitee with any such third parties.
2. As further surety for the indemnification provided herein, Indemnitor agrees to maintain a Liability Insurance Policy with a reputable Insurance Company to be approved by Indemnitee, Town of Oneonta, in an amount of coverage not less than \$1,000,000 (One Million) which shall also name as additional insured party the Town of Oneonta and the Indemnitor shall provide adequate proof of such General Liability, Automobile, Workers Compensation/Disability Insurance coverage prior to commencement of work or provision of the services or material which are to be provided pursuant to any separate agreement with the Town of Oneonta, or prior to conducting any activiites consented to by the Town of Oneonta, as the case may be.
3. The Indemnitee agrees to give immediate notice of any suits or actions of claims bought against the Indemnitee which may result in the implementation of this agreement, and the Indemnitor may have the right to participate in any such suit or action.

Town Code

Service Connection Construction

1. All curb boxes, valve gates, and fire hydrants, once installed, shall be adjusted to changes in the grade and will be kept accessible and in repair by the owner.
2. The service pipe is from the curb box shut-off to the premises and a valve is to be located just inside the building, permitting control of the water supply by the customer.
3. All service pipes shall have a minimum cover of 5 feet. NO service pipes shall be less in size than 3/4 inch inside diameter. U.S. Government Specification Type K soft tempered copper tubing shall be used on 3/4 inch and 1 inch service. Type K copper tubing shall be used on 1-1/2 inch and 2 inch services. All services larger than 2 inches in diameter shall be ductile iron pipe or quality equal to American Water Works Association standard specifications and of weight suitable for service under a pressure of 150 pounds per square inch. Pipe is to be laid on a tamped bed of sand and covered in a 3 inch tamped bed of sand. Flared fittings only are to be used outside the building. No backfilling permitted until inspected. (Contractor will be REQUIRED to uncover any work that has not been inspected by the Town Designated Water Operator or his designee)
4. All connections of service pipes to a main with a ground cover less than 5 feet shall be made on the side of the main so service pipes will not have less covering than the main. No main smaller than 6 inches will be installed and 5 feet of earth coverage and a distance of no less than 4 feet from any open area or vault shall be required.
5. The Town Designated Water District Operator will have sole discretion to postpone the proposed installation of water mains or service connections when, due to weather conditions, such installation would be impossible or would threaten the integrity of the water system.
6. All new repaired service connections will be inspected and certified by the District to be free from leaks and defects of installation(etc) before they are accepted and placed in use.
7. All excavations for installations are to be adequately guarded with barricades and lights so as to protect the public from hazard. Streets, sidewalks, parkways, and other public property disturbed in the course of the work will be restored in a manner satisfactory to the District and Highway Department.
8. Unless approved by the District, the following specifications shall be conformed to:
 - A. Pipe: Class 52 ductile iron pipe, shall be push-on joint type with rubber gaskets, four brass connecting wedges to each joint, cement lined, and tar coated to meet American National Standard Institute Specifications A-21.52.1976
 - B. Fittings: Shall be cast iron Class 250 to meet American National Standards Institute Specifications A21.11-1972 and American Water Works Association Specifications C111-72.
9. The District will furnish and maintain meters and meter couplings but the customer shall install on his premises the necessary piping, fittings, valves, and pipe couplings to receive the meter. The District will maintain meters as stated insofar as ordinary wear and tear is concerned, but in the case of damage by freezing, hot water, or external damage; the customer will be held responsible for repairs, including meter replacement. The customer will install suitable equipment, properly located and installed, to prevent back flow of hot water which may cause damage to the meter or other damage to plumbing.



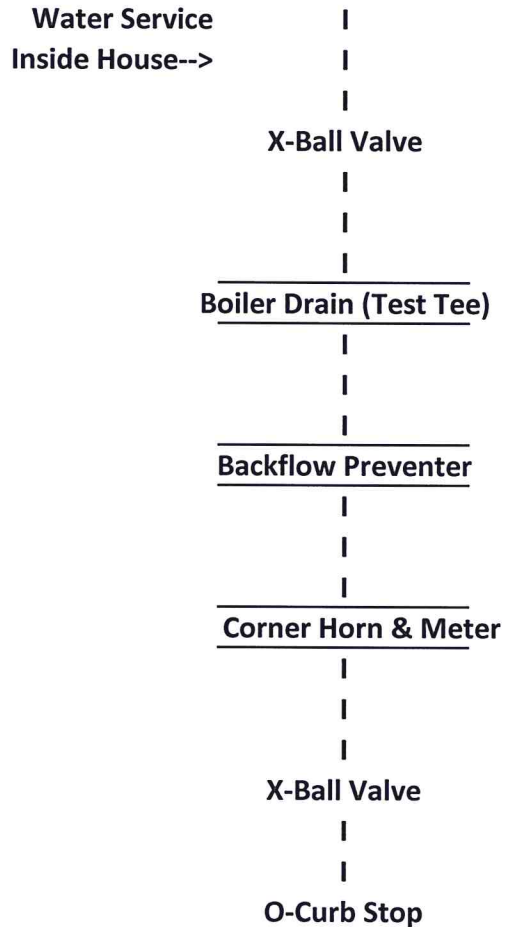
